N.B.:

- 1. In addition to aforesaid Holidays, all Courts shall remain closed on such days as are observed as local holiday in Executive Offices and also on days which are observed as Public Holidays U/s 25 of the Negotiable Instrument Act, 1881 (XXV of 1881) and also the Courts shall remain closed on such days declared as Holidays by the State Government of Manipur.
- 2. If any of the holidays for festivals, notified above does not fall on the day notified, necessary modification changing the date will be issued in due time.
- 3. All Civil Courts will remain closed on 2nd Saturday and 4th Saturday of each month. The Courts will function on other Saturday of the month from 10:00 a.m to 4:30 p.m.
- 4. All Civil Courts will enjoy the holidays declared by the High Court or the holidays declared by the State Government of Manipur on the same occasion falling on two different days.
- 5. Each employee is permitted to avail any 2 (two) days restricted holidays during the year to be chosen by him/her only with the prior sanction of the concerned Controlling Officer.
